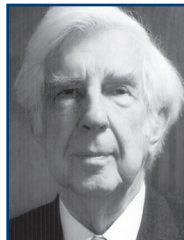


Steve Rastin

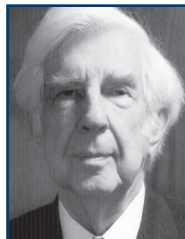
